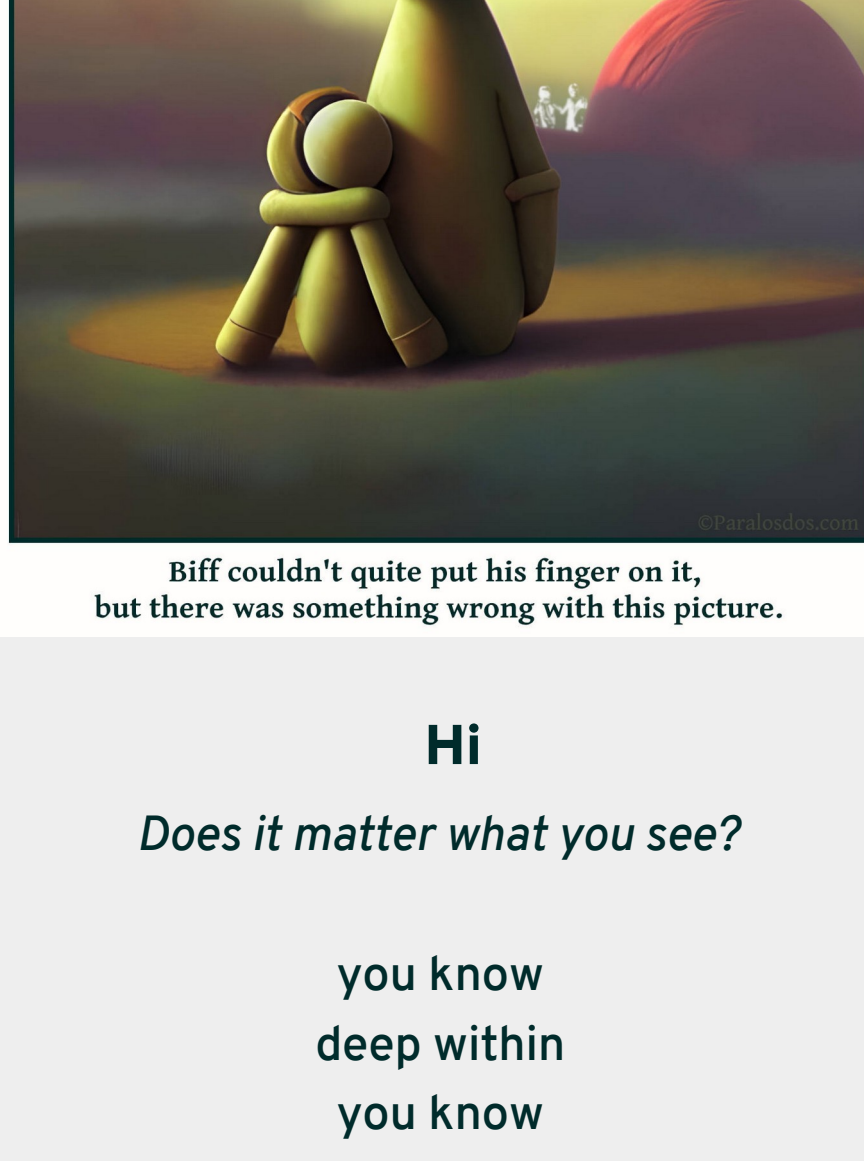

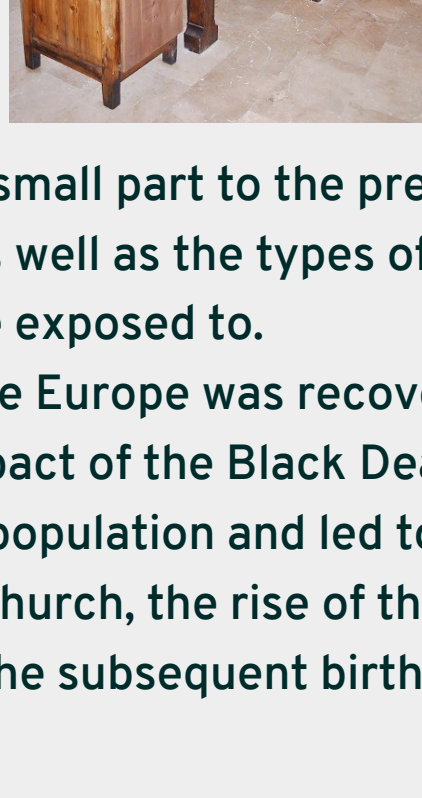

The complete story behind the invention and history of the printing press



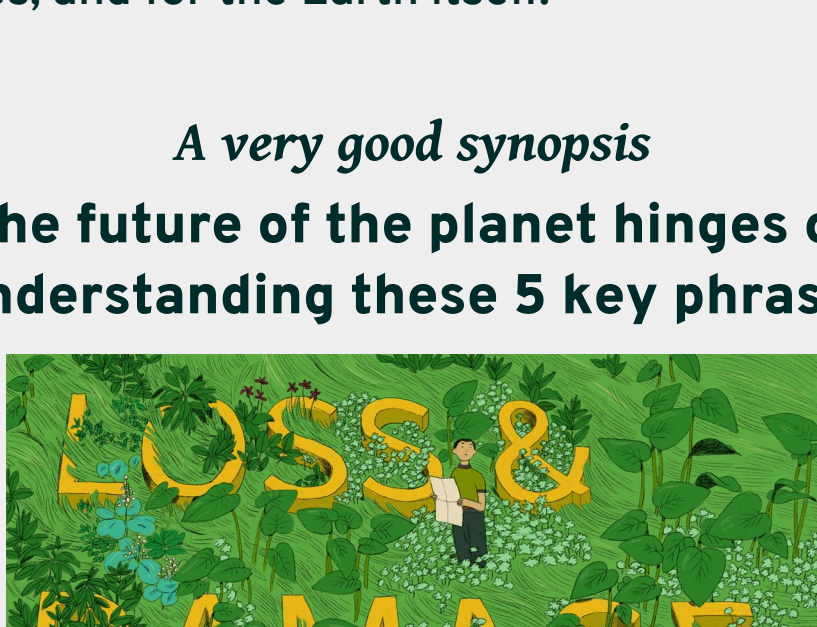
" Thanks, in no small part to the press, literacy began to rise as well as the types of information people could be exposed to.

Around this time Europe was recovering from the devastating impact of the Black Death. This decimated the population and led to the decline in the rise of the church, the rise of the money economy, and the subsequent birth of the Renaissance.

On the back of this, the printing press was 'in the right place at the right time' to help in the secularisation of Western culture. "

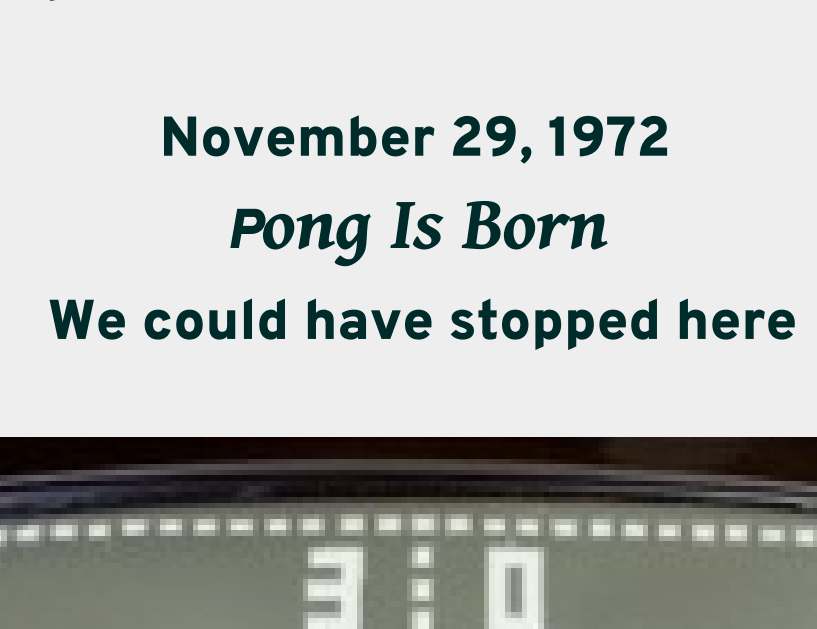
The final frontier? How humans could live underwater in 'ocean stations'

The future of the planet hinges on understanding these 5 key phrases



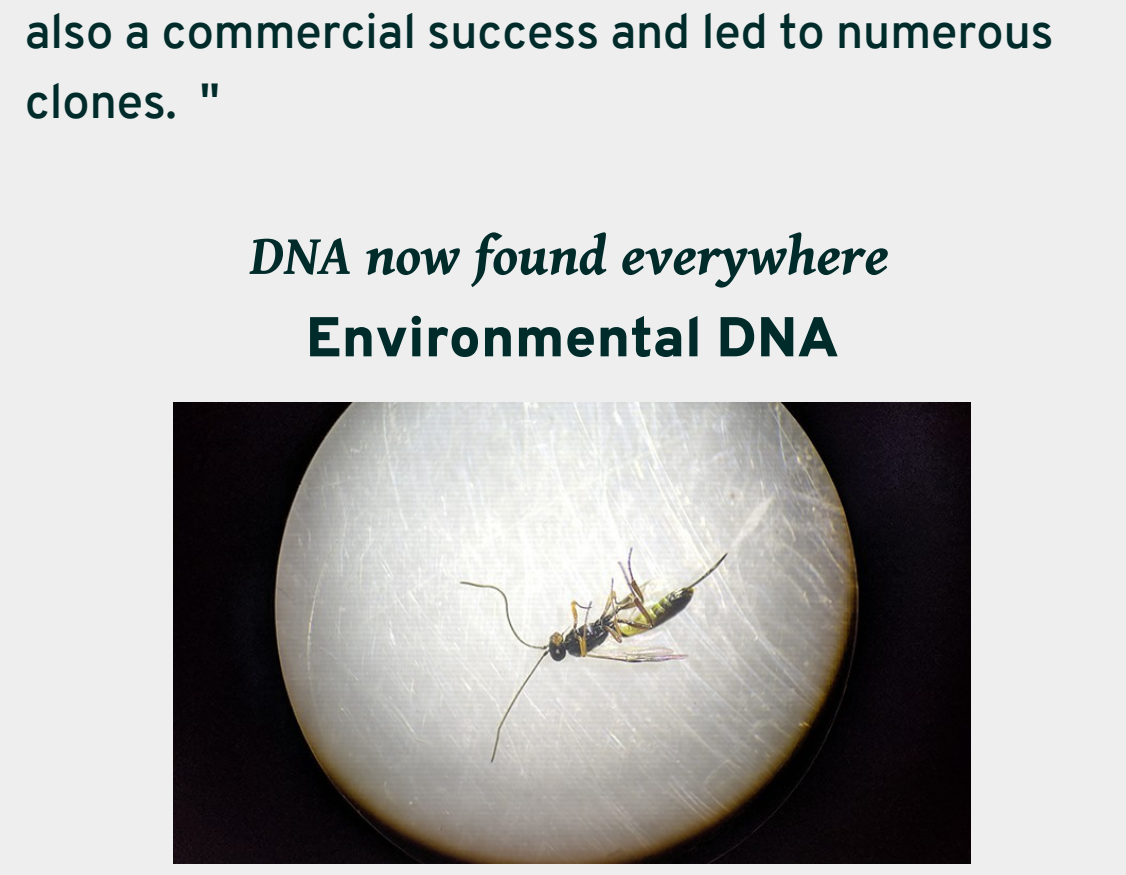
" To really boil it down, there are two broad courses of action we need to take at once: reducing emissions to limit global warming and reducing the harm from the warming we've already caused. The longer we wait to slash emissions from the fossil fuel industry, which has disproportionately caused the crisis, the more we'll pay to adapt to the harms of climate change.

To help clarify the most important debates that underscore our current moment, there are five concepts to keep in mind. Together they help make sense of what needs to be done about supercharged heat waves, hurricanes, and other troubling thresholds on the horizon. "

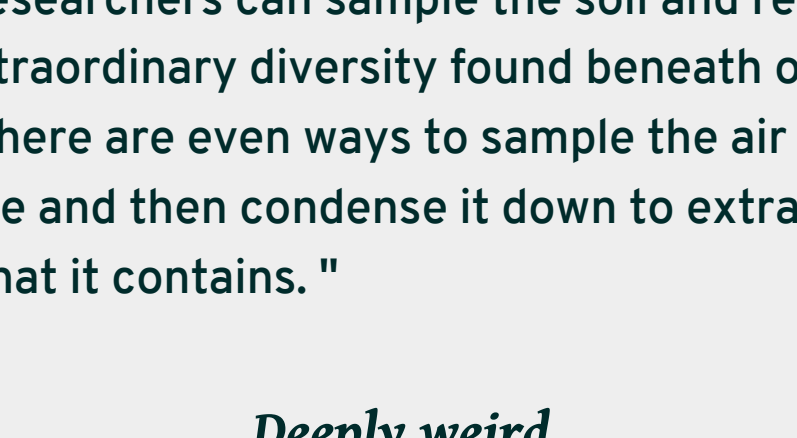

" Pong is a table tennis-themed twitch arcade sports video game, featuring simple two-dimensional graphics, manufactured by Atari and originally released in 1972. It was one of the earliest arcade video games; it was created by Allan Alcorn as a training exercise assigned to him by Atari co-founder Nolan Bushnell, but Bushnell and Atari co-founder Ted Dabney were surprised by the quality of Alcorn's work and decided to manufacture the game.

Atari released several sequels to Pong that built upon the original's gameplay by adding new features. During the 1975 Christmas season, Atari released a home version of Pong exclusively through Sears retail stores. The home version was also a commercial success and led to numerous clones. "

DNA now found everywhere

Environmental DNA



" One of the most common current uses of eDNA is to sample water. Taking a sample of water from the bottom of the ocean can, for example, give a rich picture of what lives down in the inaccessible depths, revealing the presence of deep diving whales, fish or crustaceans.

But over the years its applications have ballooned. Now researchers can sample the soil and reveal the extraordinary diversity found beneath our feet. There are even ways to sample the air we breathe and then condense it down to extract any DNA that it contains. "

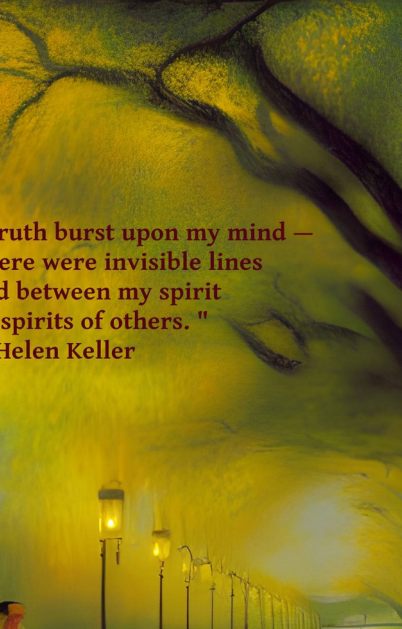
Bizarre Deep Sea Creatures

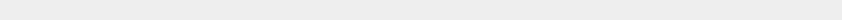
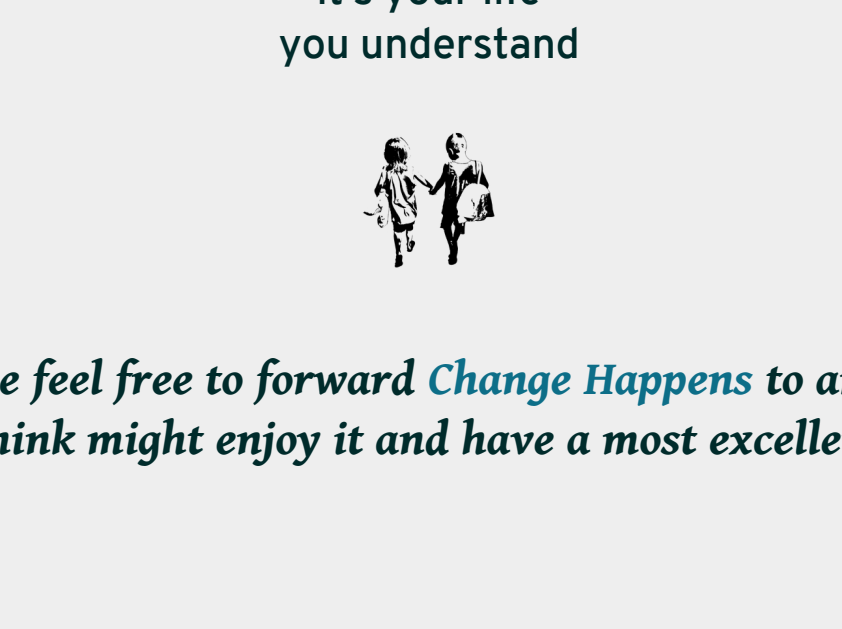
How the Zamboni Revolutionized Fun on the Ice
