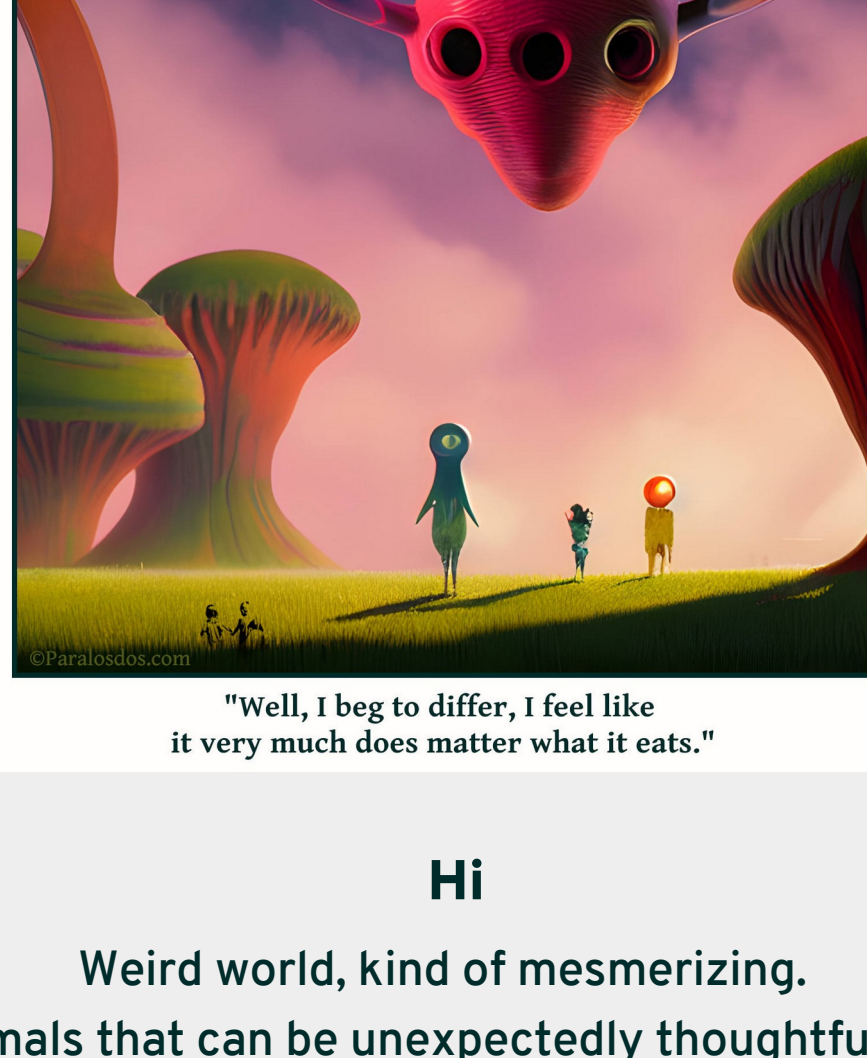

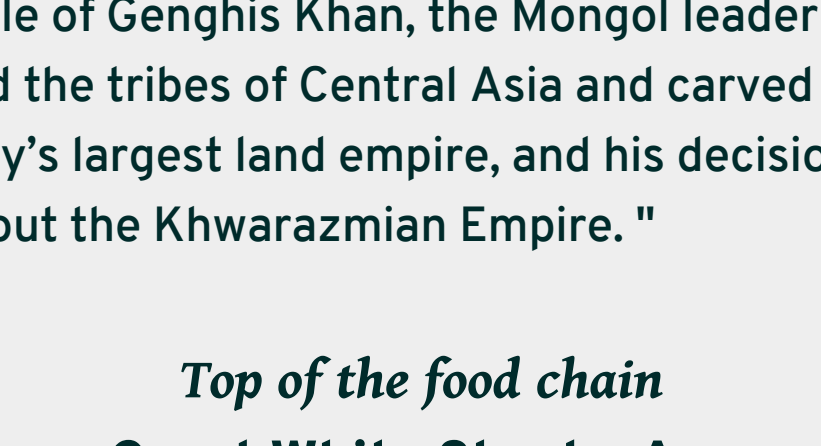

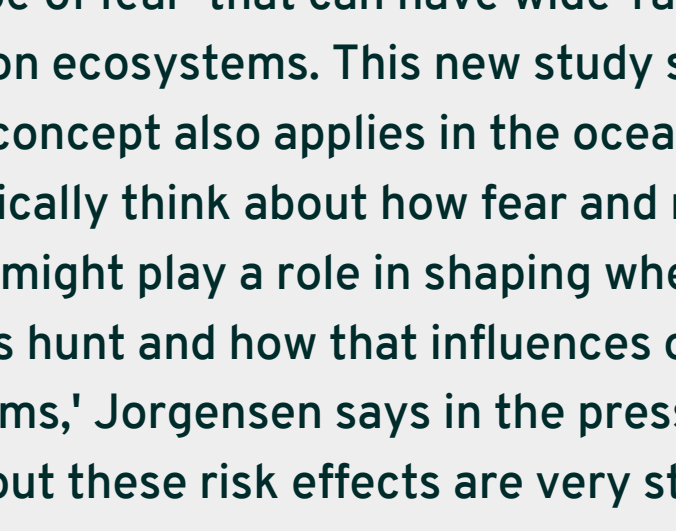
The insult that sparked Genghis Khan to destroy an empire

Top of the food chain

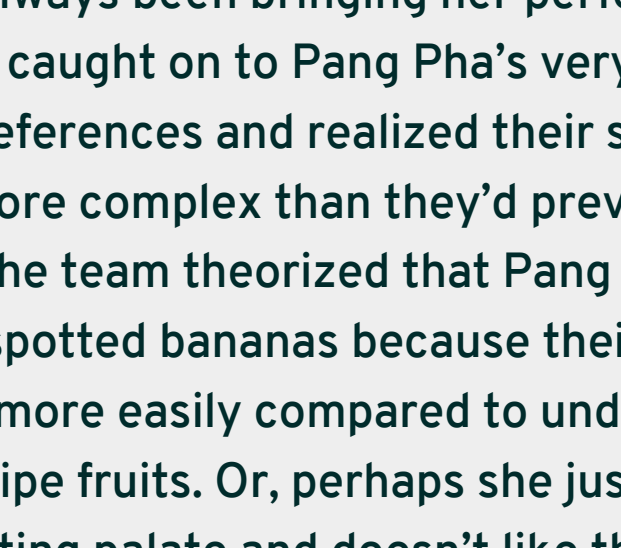
Great White Sharks Are Completely Terrified of Orcas



" Researchers are beginning to understand how the instinct to avoid predators creates a 'landscape of fear' that can have wide-ranging impacts on ecosystems. This new study shows that the concept also applies in the oceans. 'We don't typically think about how fear and risk aversion might play a role in shaping where large predators hunt and how that influences ocean ecosystems,' Jorgensen says in the press release. 'It turns out these risk effects are very strong even for large predators like white sharks—strong enough to redirect their hunting activity to less preferred but safer areas.' "

Watch This Elephant Peel a Banana With Her Trunk

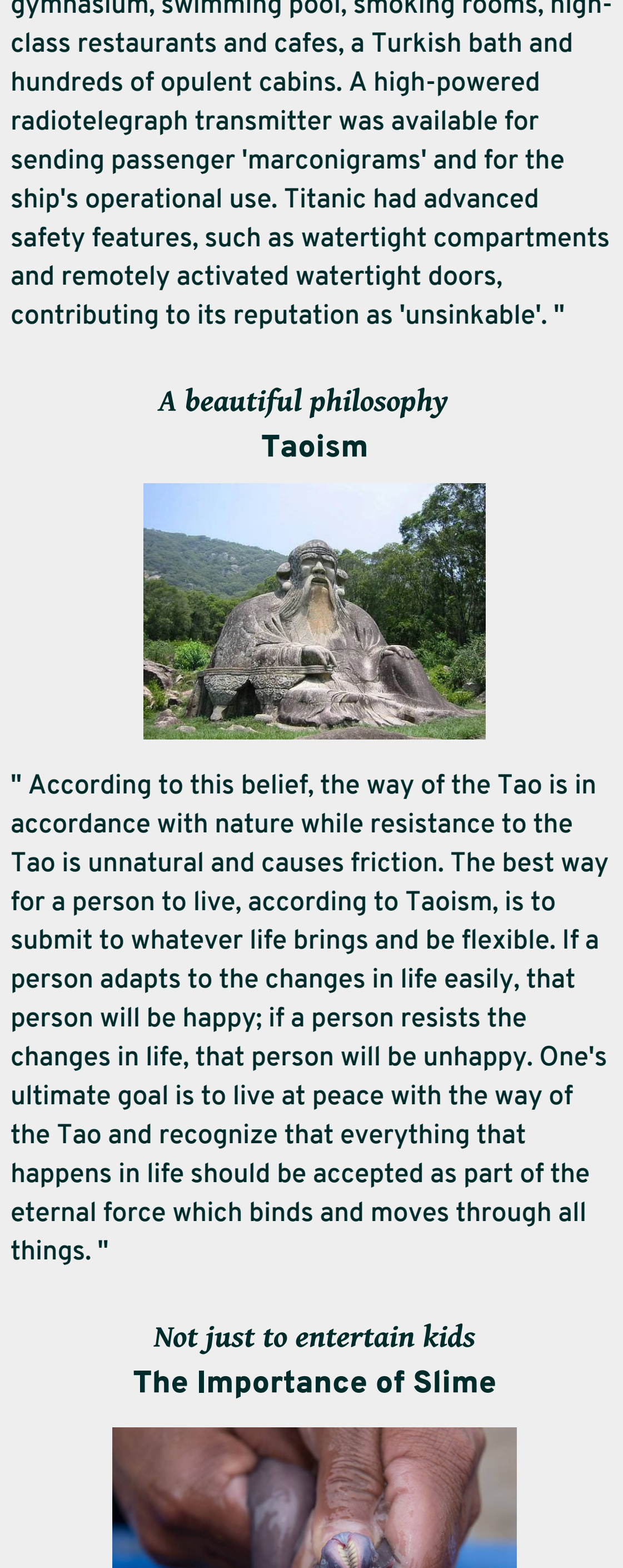

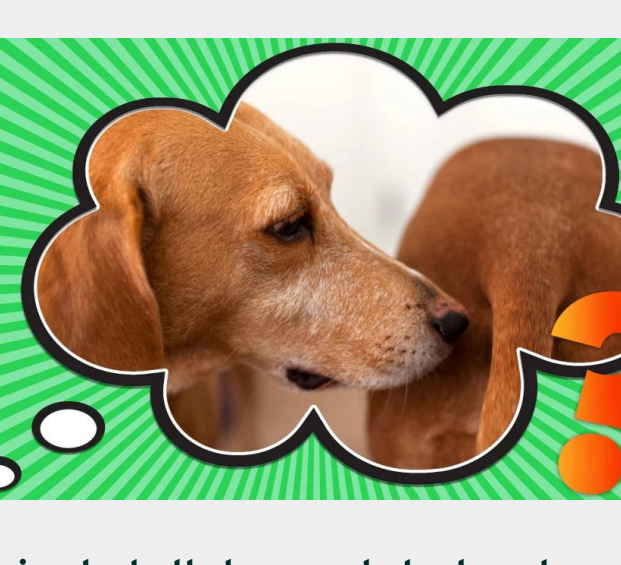

" The first-class accommodation was designed to be the pinnacle of comfort and luxury, with a gymnasium, swimming pool, smoking rooms, high-class restaurants and cafes, a Turkish bath and hundreds of opulent cabins. A high-powered radiotelegraph transmitter was available for sending passenger 'marconigrams' and for the ship's operational use. Titanic had advanced safety features, such as watertight compartments and remotely activated watertight doors, contributing to its reputation as 'unsinkable'. "

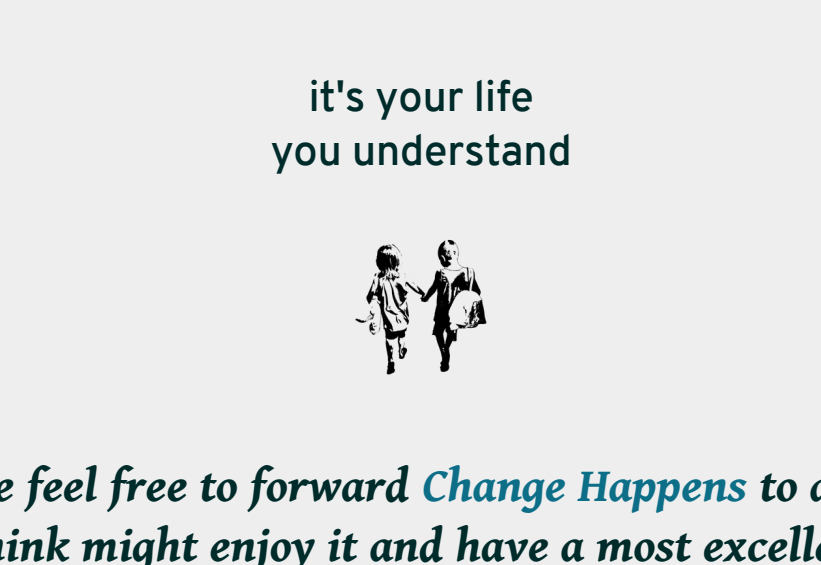
The Importance of Slime



" But neither does the hagfish have many predators. Its loose skin makes it too difficult to catch, and there's the extremely slimy defense. When threatened, hagfish release extra-long molecules from their skin, stored as space-saving spindles, waiting to be put into action. Then they positively explode, binding vast quantities of water into a dense slime in a split second, forming a suffocating cloud of gel that will even gag a shark. The tens of thousands of fibers in each liter of hagfish slime are long and thin yet durable and elastic, a bit like robust silk or synthetic fibers. And, as entirely natural molecules, they could just show the way toward novel eco-textiles. "
