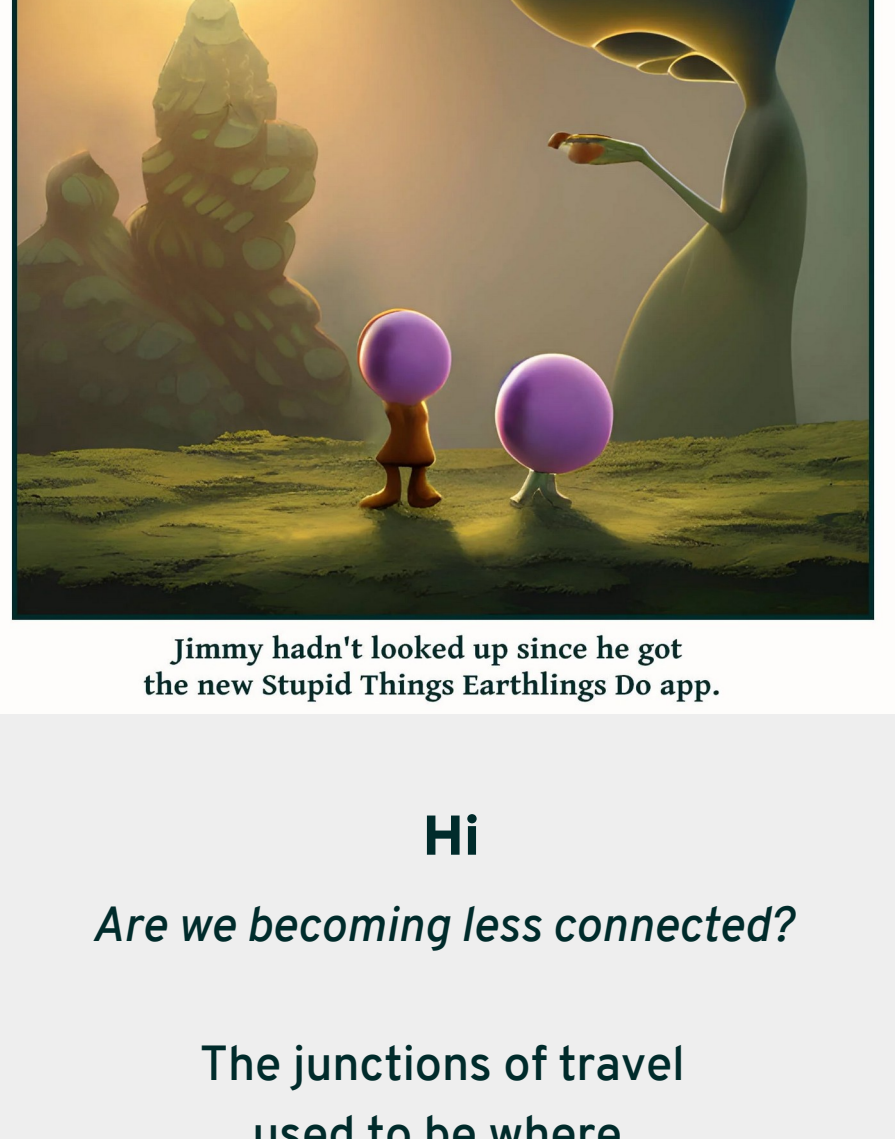

Are we becoming less connected?

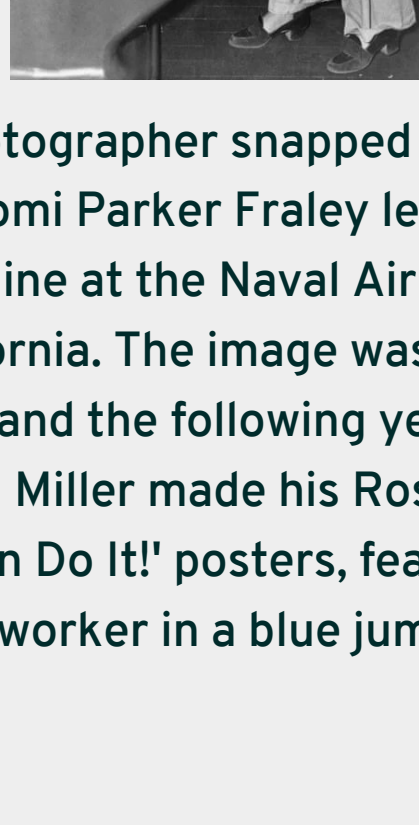
The junctions of travel

The image was published in the local press and the following year graphic artist J Howard Miller made his Rosie the Riveter "We Can Do It!" posters, featuring a flexing female factory worker in a blue jumpsuit and red headscarf. "

Classic optical illusions

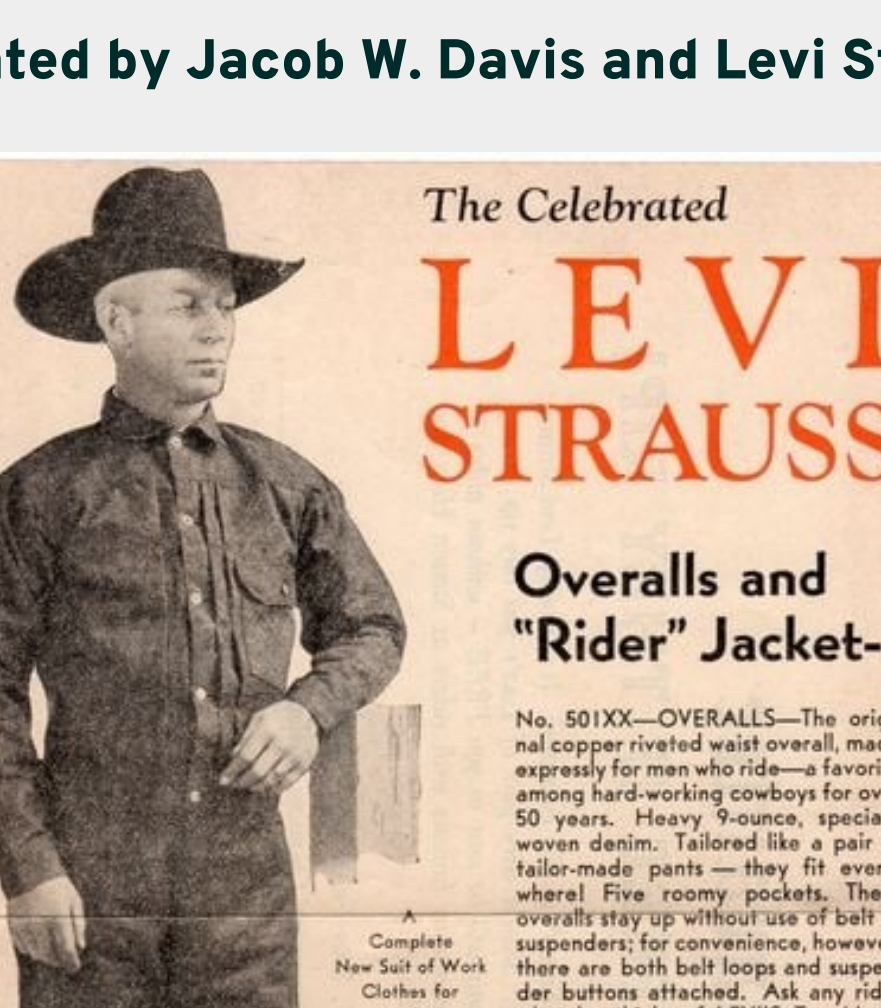


" While both the artist's wife and mother-in-law are visible in this drawing, our eyes can only perceive one at a time.

First Aid Basics: Essential Skills Everyone Should Know



" Before approaching someone, who needs help:

- Check for potential dangers such as fire, smoke, traffic, electricity, or violence. -If the scene is unsafe, do not enter it and call for help instead.
- If the location is safe, approach the person and check if they are conscious and breathing. If they are not, contact emergency services immediately and start CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation). CPR has been explained later in this article.
- If they are aware, ask them what happened and if they have any pain or medical conditions.
- Until assistance arrives, try to make them feel comfortable. "

Reasons You're a Mosquito Magnet

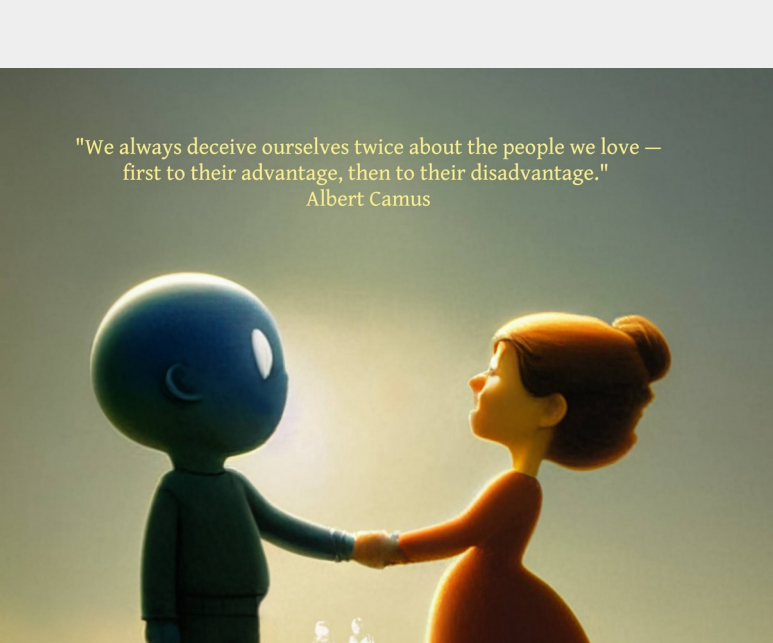


" Do you know someone who always seems to get bitten by mosquitoes? Research shows that some people really are "mosquito magnets."

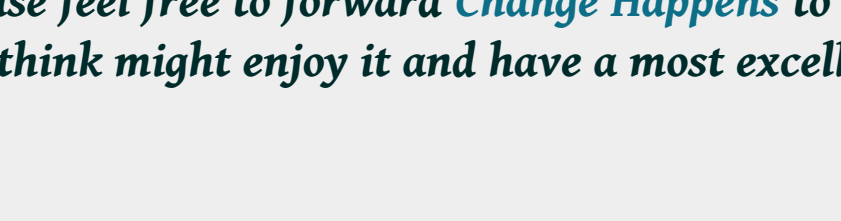
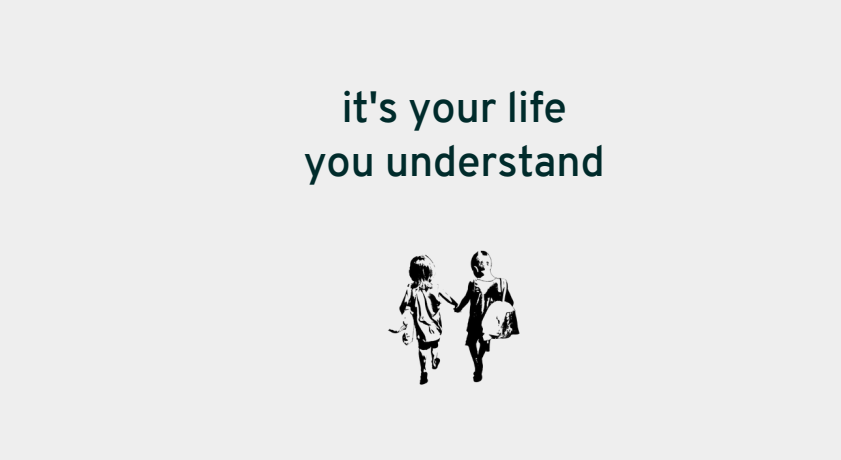

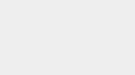
